

MINIMUM GUIDELINES TO BE CONSIDERED A JUNIOR CLUB
WITHIN THE OKLAHOMA REGION

- Every player and coach must be a fully registered member of OkRVA. (A player may not be associated with more than one team within the same playing season.)
- Each team must be registered with a minimum of 6 players and a coach...
- Each junior division team must have an Impact Certified Coach and/or Assistant Coach registered and on the bench at all times.
- Each junior division team must NOT have any adult person associated, affiliated, involved with such team/club without prior Back Ground clearance from the nationally suggested investigation company. (If in doubt of any such person, contact Regional Office)
- Each club/team must sanction all tryout's to include date, time, location and divisions offered. Failure to do so will result in a \$500 sanction penalty. Sanction must be requested and approved before advertising of tryout information.
- Multi-team clubs must report to the Commissioner each season, their newly elected officers of club – in applicable.
- A registered team must participate in no fewer than 2 Oklahoma sanctioned tournaments within their playing classification before they can enter into the Regional Championship per season.
- Club/Team will have on hand a signed Coaches Contract and Code of Ethics.
- Club/Team shall report any player who drops or a player who is dropped from a team within one (1) week of doing so, with explanation.
- Club/Team must report any penalties that they enforce on a player or a coach to the Commissioner within one (1) week of penalty.
- A club director or another officer of their club is encouraged to attend any and all OkRVA meetings.
- Club/Team is highly encouraged to report any and all player's who have not fulfilled financial obligation during the immediate playing season, no later than August 1st each year.
- Club/Team shall report any recruiting violations to Commissioner.
- Club/Team will provide a list of players considered “not in good standing” to the Commissioner no later than August 1 each year.
- Club/Team shall submit their player's agreements, signed parents agreements and forms, etc., to the Commissioner within 72 hours if requested.
- Club/Team shall report dissolution of any team within a 72 hour time frame to the Commissioner.

Failure to adhere to the guidelines for maintaining a Junior Club within the Oklahoma region may result in penalties and or dissolution of club as voted on by the Board of Directors. (2000 and revised 2004)
